

Report of the Group of Eminent Technical Experts (GETE) on the technical evaluation of bids received on Restructuring and Modernization of Delhi and Mumbai Airports.

1. Authority:

1.1. The Cabinet Secretariat vide its Order No.071/2/6/2005-Cab.III dt.27th December, 2005 constituted a Group of Eminent Technical Experts (GETE) comprising of Shri E. Sreedharan, MD, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and Shri R. Sivadasan, Financial Commissioner, M/o Railways "to get the technical pre-qualification of Joint Venture partners in terms of the bid criteria scrutinized comprehensively". The other terms of reference to the GETE may be seen at Annexure-A.

1.2 The Group was provided technical assistance by Shri Satendra Singh, Director General, Directorate General of Civil Aviation.

1.3 The Group was provided the required support by Shri Sanjay Narayan, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Dr. A.R. Sinha, Joint Secretary, Cabinet Secretariat

2. Deliberations of GETE:

2.1. The Group of Eminent Technical Experts (GETE) had their first meeting and deliberations on Friday, 30th December, 2005. For the benefit of the GETE, a presentation was made on behalf of the Evaluation Committee (EC) by the Financial Consultant, M/S ABN-AMRO (Shri Sangameswararam Manikkam, and Shri Kanishka Ghoshal) when the Legal Consultant's representative, Shri Jatin Anuja was also present. The presentation was basically for explaining the contents of the Request for Proposal (RFP), the approach adopted by the E.C. in evaluating the technical bids and the views expressed by Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) on the EC evaluation. The E.C. explained that the weightage marks
